



Namibia Photographic Safari: Etosha

Travel

This tour is from Windhoek or can be combined as an after hunting tour (or any other place depending on clients) to Etosha. You will be travelling approximately 1150 km's in 5 days.

The tour will take us through Etosha National Park, to the Northern part of Namibia and will be travelling in 4x4 vehicles.

The cost of the tour package will be **USD \$ (USD \$)** per person sharing. **This price is based on 2 people. Group prices available on request.**

Included in package price:

- all transportation within the tour
- accommodation
- documents, visa's, park entrance fees
- some day activities, (noted in day description)
- all meals and assorted beverages,

Excluded in package price:

- flights to Windhoek, Namibia
- gratuities for tour guides in parks and day activities (your own discretion)

Day 1: Etosha National Park

Driving distance from Windhoek to Etosha National Park is 550 km and driving should be approximately 6 hours.

“Etosha National Park is one of the largest game reserves in Africa and covers a vast area of 22,270 square km. Visiting the park is a great opportunity to see some more of Africa animals, including 4 of the big 5 (rhino, elephant, lion, cape buffalo & leopard) in their natural environment. There are 114 mammal species in the park and several are rare and endangered. The park is also the world’s largest sanctuary for the endangered black rhino. About 340 bird species can be found, of which about one third is migratory. In the dry season Etosha’s wildlife is dependent on water holes, which offer excellent game viewing and photographic opportunities.”

“Okaukuejo is located 17 km from the southern entrance of the park, and famous for its flood-lit waterhole, where visitors can observe at close quarters a spectacle of wildlife congregating and interacting.”

Mount Etjo Safari Lodge is where the most important Declaration towards Namibia's Independence was signed in 1989 (The Mount Etjo Declaration).
